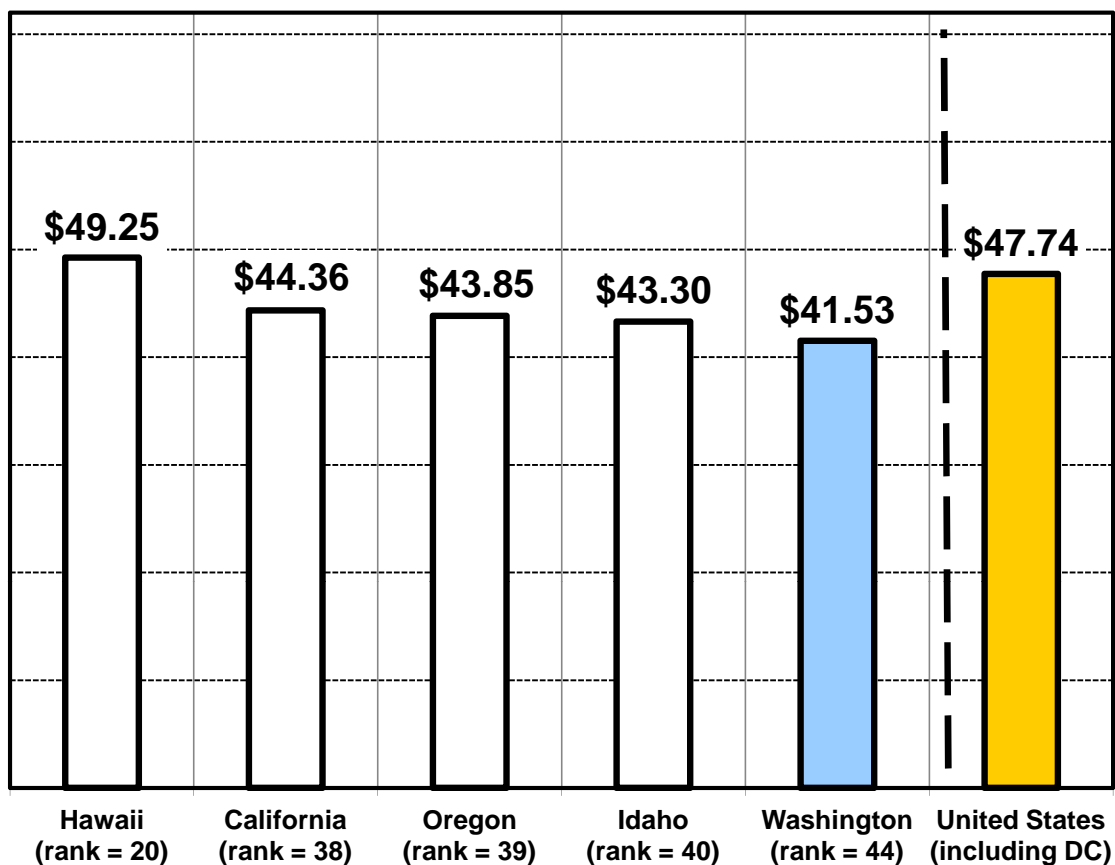


Revenues for Washington's K-12 public schools are lower than those for other states.

Washington ranks 44th in revenues per \$1,000 of personal income for public elementary and secondary schools.

"Revenues" includes all money received by a school system from external sources other than from issuance of debt or liquidation of investments. Does not include non-cash transactions such as receipt of services, commodities or other receipts in kind.
